What: The Technical Advisory Committee, or "TAC", refers to the technical experts appointed by the Board to provide recommendations regarding public policy or expenditure of funds for the benefit of the watershed and to carry on technical and other investigations of all kinds, make measurements, collect data, and make analyses, studies, and inspections pertaining to facilities, projects, and related property both within and outside the district.

# Guiding Documents

- Bylaws establish the roles and responsibilities of the TAC, membership, and committee procedures
- The <u>2022 Capital Improvement Plan</u> documents recommendations made by the Monetary Mitigation Fund Advisory Committee to the Board of Directors of the District for projects that will be executed in the current calendar year.
- The <u>Fountain Creek Floodplain Management Opportunities Study (2019)</u> provides a repeatable framework for identifying and prioritizing floodplain management projects along the entire stretch of the mainstem of the Fountain Creek Corridor
- The <u>Fountain Creek Corridor Restoration Master Plan (2011)</u> establishes a revitalization concept vision for the reach of Fountain Creek between the southern Colorado Springs City limit line and the confluence with the Arkansas River in Pueblo

## Permitting and Projects

- SDS 1041 Permit establishes the funding parameters that allow the District to undertake projects that "create a significant and not merely incidental benefit to Fountain Creek within Pueblo County for improvement of water quality, for flood control, or for the prevention of erosion and sedimentation" (Pueblo County SDS 1041 Permit).
- The <u>Land Use Application</u> is required for District approval of all projects located in whole or in part within the Fountain Creek Corridor. The District has full land use authority for projects within the one-hundred-year floodplain of the Fountain Creek Corridor.
