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2. Approve Previous Meeting Agenda: Dave Allgood made a motion for approval of Agenda, Mark Shea seconded.
3. Approve Minutes of Prior Meeting – May 6, 2026: Minutes were reviewed. Motion to approve by Mark Shea, Dave Allgood seconded.
4. Committee Member Comments:
 - a. Alli Schuch introduced Hadid Poveda Morales who will be with the FCWD year for a full year.
5. Presentations – None.
6. Current Business/Discussion:
 - a. District Updates
 - i. Alli Schuch reported that GEI is providing an ILF User Guide, Gantt Chart, use templates, and outreach plan. There will be another practitioner workshop in October. The next Board meeting is Friday, August 28.
 - ii. Steve Rodriguez reported on [Maintenance reports](#) of current projects including:
 1. Eagleridge/Southmoor
 - a. Revegetation efforts are under ongoing monitoring.
 2. Frost Ranch Creek Restoration Project
 - a. Observed reduction in flow due to levee breach upstream of the Irvine Ditch diversion at the Sundance Property. Any future assessments of the project should include full flow conditions. Design work is currently at 60% and will continue.
 3. Resiliency Study
 - a. Currently under contract with Stantec and working on owner access to property in the creek for surveys.
 - b. Monetary Mitigation Fund Committee
 - i. The next MMF Meeting will be scheduled after the Resiliency study is completed, projected for September.
 - c. Citizens Advisory Group



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- i. David Woolley reported that CAG met May 2026 and saw a presentation from the Palmer Land Conservancy and the Manitou Garden club. The next meeting will be August 13, 2026.
- d. AFCURE
 - i. Yvonne Wetzig shared that AFCURE met August 4, 2026. PPACG gave an update on their 208 plan. Security Sanitation gave a review of their Waste Water Treatment Facility expansion project. The National Water Research Institute has published its final report. Mindi May from CPW gave a presentation on the impacts Nitrite may have on aquatic life. The next meeting is September 1, 2026.
- e. In Lieu Fee Subcommittee
 - i. Mark Shea reported that ILF met August 4, 2026. The ILF subcommittee meetings will increase meeting frequency to twice a month. Grant funding has been secured for a data dashboard with the FCWD and an internal version will be used for ILF. The 2026 schedule of remaining deliverables was reviewed in preparation for presenting to the FCWD Board. GEI is supporting the development of a site selection matrix which will work in tandem with the internal data dashboard and GIS mapping tool. Input from EPA, FCWD Board, and USACE are being addressed. The developed cost construction worksheet will be reviewed. The next standing meeting is September 8, 2026.

 - a. FCWD Land Use Authority Process
 - i. Alli Schuch presented the [DCM Comparison Matrix](#) for discussion with the TAC. Mapping work is ongoing for LUA boundary. The review of the DCM and supplemental documentation will be discussed in future TAC meetings.
 - ii. Alli Schuch presented a discussion on [draft language](#) for commenting authority relating project work outside of the LUA corridor. Commenting authority language will be reviewed again in the September TAC meeting prior to presenting to the FCWD Board and outreach to adjacent jurisdictions.
 - b. TACAG Tour debrief
 - i. Yvonne Wetzig spoke about the TACAG tour held on July 31, 2026. Colorado Springs Utilities hosted a group to showcase recent Wildfire Resiliency project work along North Catamount Creek. The project utilizes Low Tech Process Based Restoration work and fuels mitigation to reduce impacts to water infrastructure, supply, and environment due to fire.
